Sub.: Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram – Renewal of Permission for admission of 4th Batch of MBBS students against the increased intake i.e. from 100-150 for the academic session 2019-20 – regarding.

Sir,

Whereas an assessment to assess the physical and other teaching facilities available for renewal of permission for admission of 4th Batch of MBBS students against the increased intake i.e. from 100-150 at Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic session 2019-20 was carried out by the Council assessors on 23rd & 24th January, 2019 and the Board of Governors in Supersession of Medical Council noted the following deficiencies:-

1. Deficiency of faculty – 16.9%.
2. Deficiency of Residents – 11.76%.
3. Bed occupancy – 51%.
4. OPD on day of assessment is 9000 (instead of 1120 required).

It was also noted that for 100 MBBS seats the college has following deficiencies :-

1. Shortage of Faculty – 12.90% (16/124)
2. Shortage of Resident – 9.37% (6/64)
3. Bed occupancy – 67.4% (337/500).

2. Whereas the Medical Council of India vide its letter dated 22.02.2019 sought an explanation/ point-wise compliance with documentary evidence in support of claim of rectification of the deficiency noted by the Board of Governors from the college authorities within 30 days and also invited the attention of the clause 8(3)(1)(C) of the Establishment of Medical College Regulation (Amendment), 2010(Part II), dated 16th April, 2010 and amended from time to time.

3. Whereas on receipt of the compliance from the college authorities, the compliance verification assessment of Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram was carried out by the Council Assessors on 11.05.2019.

4. Whereas the Board of Governors considered the compliance verification assessment report (11.05.2019) alongwith the summary/observations of the member of the undergraduate expert group appointed by the BOG and noted that the following deficiencies:-

to MCI Cell



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I. For 100-150 seats

1. Deficiency of Faculty – 26.61% (37/139).
2. Deficiency of Residence – 23.59% (16/68).

II. For 100 seats

1. Deficiency of Faculty – 25.78% (33/128).
3. Deficiency of Residence – 20.3% (13/64).

5. Whereas with the promulgation of Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Ordinance 2018 on 26th September, 2018 and promulgation of Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Second Ordinance 2019 on 21st February, 2019, the Medical Council of India stands superseded by the Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India, and the Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India have been vested with the powers of Central Government also under Section 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

6. Whereas as per Section 10A(4) of the Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act, 1956, the institute was granted hearing on 28.05.2019 in the Council Office to present the case of the institute in view of the above deficiencies and the Hearing Committee, after considering the submissions/compliance furnished by the college observed as under:-

"The explanation offered by the college authorities regarding the significant deficiency of Faculty & Residents, was found unsatisfactory by the Hearing Committee.

In view of the above, the Hearing Committee recommended not to grant renewal of permission against increased intake from 100 to 150 MBBS seats for the academic session 2019-20 and invoke Clause 8 (3) (1) (c) of the Establishment of Medical College Regulations, 1999."

6 Now therefore, accepting the recommendation of the Hearing Committee, the Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India hereby decided not to renew the permission for admission of 4th Batch of MBBS students against the increased intake i.e. from 100-150 at Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic session 2019-20. The college is accordingly directed not to admit any students in MBBS course against the increased intake i.e. from 100-150 for the academic session 2019-2020. However, the college is free to apply afresh for next academic year strictly as per provisions of IMC Act, 1956 and Regulations framed there under.

7. Whereas the Board of Governors further decided to apply clause 8(3)(1)(C) of the Establishment of Medical College Regulation (Amendment), 2010 (Part II), dated 16th April, 2010 and amended on 5th February, 2019 which reads as under:-

"8(3)(1).....

- (c) Colleges which are already recognized for award of MBBS degree and/or running postgraduate courses

If it is observed during any inspection/assessment of the institute that the deficiency of teaching faculty and/or Residents is more than 10% and/or bed occupancy is less than 70%, compliance of rectification of deficiency from such an institute will not be considered for issue of renewal of permission in that Academic year and further such an institute will not be



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considered for processing applications for postgraduate courses in that Academic year and will be issued show cause notices as to why the recommendation for withdrawal of recognition of the courses run by that institute should not be made for undergraduate and postgraduate courses which are recognized u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act,1956 along with direction of stoppage of admissions in permitted postgraduate courses....".

8. Whereas in view of above, it was decided not to consider the institute for processing applications for postgraduate courses in the current Academic year (2020-21) and to issue show cause notice as to why the recommendation for withdrawal of recognition of the courses run by that institute should not be made for undergraduate and postgraduate courses which are recognized u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956, along with direction of stoppage of admissions in permitted postgraduate courses and further decided that the institute be asked to submit the compliance of rectification of the above deficiencies within 01 month
